"Hola" is the most common way of greeting someone in Spanish and replying back with a simple "Hola" will do the trick.

Adding "Buenos dias/tardes/noches" depending the time of the day will sound much better, and you can reply with a "Buenos días/tardes/noches" as well.

Among men its common to shake hands In some Latin American countries, it's common to give iust one kiss on the cheek.




